Exposed to Infinity - An exposed job site required Janice Parker to keep her design well edited and disciplined. Her clients recently purchased the property and found their property was not conducive to outside entertainment, the pool was in disrepair, and the overall aesthetic did not fit their personal de-

sign sensibilities. The requirements were clean and modern. After a thorough pool design assessment, the existing pool was removed. An infinity edge pool replaced it, and while this is not a typical application—infinity to land it impacted the property with the dramatic modern feeling it was lacking. Lending a much different sense, Parker changed the proportions of the pool by lengthening and narrowing its dimensions.

Because the yard sits on top of a hill it is

very open and exposed. Plants were selected based upon their durability, such as lilacs, sugar maples and crab apples. A small apple orchard was also added. All of the granite was hand selected from the local Roxbury quarry, adding life to the areas surrounding the pool and patio areas.
